DAY ONE- 11 FEB 2023

Welcome to NYC! You will welcomed on arrival and transferred to your hotel in a private coach. Check in and relax on your first evening in New York.

DAY TWO- 12 FEB 2023- ONE WORLD TRADE CENTRE, THE 9/11 MEMORIAL & WALL STREET, STATEN ISLAND

Begin your exploration of New York with a visit to the One World Trade Centre which stands next to the the original World Trade Centre.

Those interested can visit the One World Observatory on the 104'th floor where you can take in fascinating views of Manhattan, the Statue of Liberty, Brooklyn, Staten Island and New Jersey.




Later visit the 9/11 Memorial Plaza, an 8 acre park where the original World Trade Centre stood once.

The foundations of the Twin Tower are converted into reflecting pools and the surrounding area is now a grove of trees. You will then proceed to visit the 9/11 Museum with your guide and learn about the story of 9/11 through a series of exhibits, artifacts and interactive technology. You can also visit the Oculus, a transport hub, a brand new state of the art train station.

After lunch, wander through the Financial district and take a stroll down Wall Street. You can choose to board a ferry to Staten Island or decide to spend the rest of the evening at leisure at your hotel.







DAY 03 - 13 FEB '23- NEW YORK LIBRARY, GRAND CENTRAL TERMINAL, MIDTOWN WALKING TOUR, TIMES SQUARE.



Visit the iconic New York public library featured in few movies like "Day after Tomorrow" and "Ghostbusters" and take in the vast collection. With more than 50 million books in its collection, this is the largest public library in the world.

A few blocks from the Library is Grand Central Terminal. Built in 1871 this is the oldest railway station and its 44 platforms also makes it one the largest in the world. The main concourse is definitely a must-visit spot, especially if you love people watching. You can walk up to the Apple store and get a front row seat to all the action as hundreds of people crisscross the main concourse.

Walk down Fifth avenue, one of the most famous streets in the world known for its high-end shops and enjoy some window shopping (and real shopping for those interested). Your walk will culminate at Times Square, one of the most iconic locations not just in the United States but in the world.



DAY 04 -14 FEB '23 - CENTRAL PARK, METROPOLITAN ART MUSEUM, THEATRE DISTRICT TOUR, BROADWAY SHOW.

Start the day with a stroll through Central Park which is one of the most visited tourist attractions in New York. Spread over 800 acres the park is a great place to walk, relax, and take in the sights and sounds of the city. There are a number of attractions within the park, including the Central Park Zoo, the Central Park Conservatory Garden. Take a selfie by John Lennon's 'Imagine Mosaic' or visit the Sheep meadow and the Mall.

Later, visit the Metropolitan Museum of Art (MET)to see one of the best collections of ancient arts from all around the World.

In the evening go on a walking tour of the theatre district with our expert guide who will give you a close peek into the theatre scene in New York. The day will end with a spectacular Broadway show experience –an experience of a lifetime.









DAY 05 - 15 FEB '23 - STATUE OF LIBERTY AND ELLIS ISLAND

Board a ferry from Battery Park, which is closest to Manhattan, and take a a round trip excursion to the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. A gift from the people of France to United States, the Statue is an enduring symbol of freedom and democracy and is a must-see on any trip to New York

At the Statue of the Liberty you can climb to the base of the statue or all the way up to the crown.

Later visit the Ellis Island which was the main entry point for immigrants to the United States from 1892 to 1954. The island housed the Immigration Inspection station and approximately 12 million Immigrant applications were processed here between 1905 and 1954.

Later visit China Town or Little Italy to experience the gastronomical delights it offers.



DAY 06 - 16 FEB '23 - ACTING WORKSHOP/ BROOKLYN

Attend a half day theatre acting workshop with an academy in New York.

Next, head to Brooklyn which has become one of New York's hotspots with historic neighbourhoods, a fabulous food scene and some of the best views of Manhattan skyline. Explore Williamsburg, a friendly neighbourhood with boutique shops and Brooklyn brewery. This is a good opportunity to visit the local shops and markets and immerse yourself in the local culture.

Then take a ferry on the East River to Dumbo and the Brooklyn Bridge. From here, enjoy the best views of the Manhattan skyline, dine on the best Pizza in the city and end with a walk over the iconic Brooklyn Bridge.

DAY 07- 17 FEB '23- RETURN FLIGHT TO LONDON

Departure transfer to the Airport for your return flight home.



ACCOMMODATION & DINING

Your stay in New York will be in a comfortable hotel apartment in the heart of the Financial district. Wall Street, The Battery, and other one-of-a-kind shops and restaurants are all nearby, and the rest of New York City is just a quick walk or subway trip away. Each space offers a fully equipped kitchen, and access to a fitness center. The seasonal rooftop overlooks the city and Brooklyn Bridge. The apartment hotel also offers an expansive lounge and communal kitchen.

You can stock up breakfast essentials from the nearby shops. You will be out and about on most days and will have access to a variety of options for lunch. This itinerary includes dinner on all days at select restaurants.
